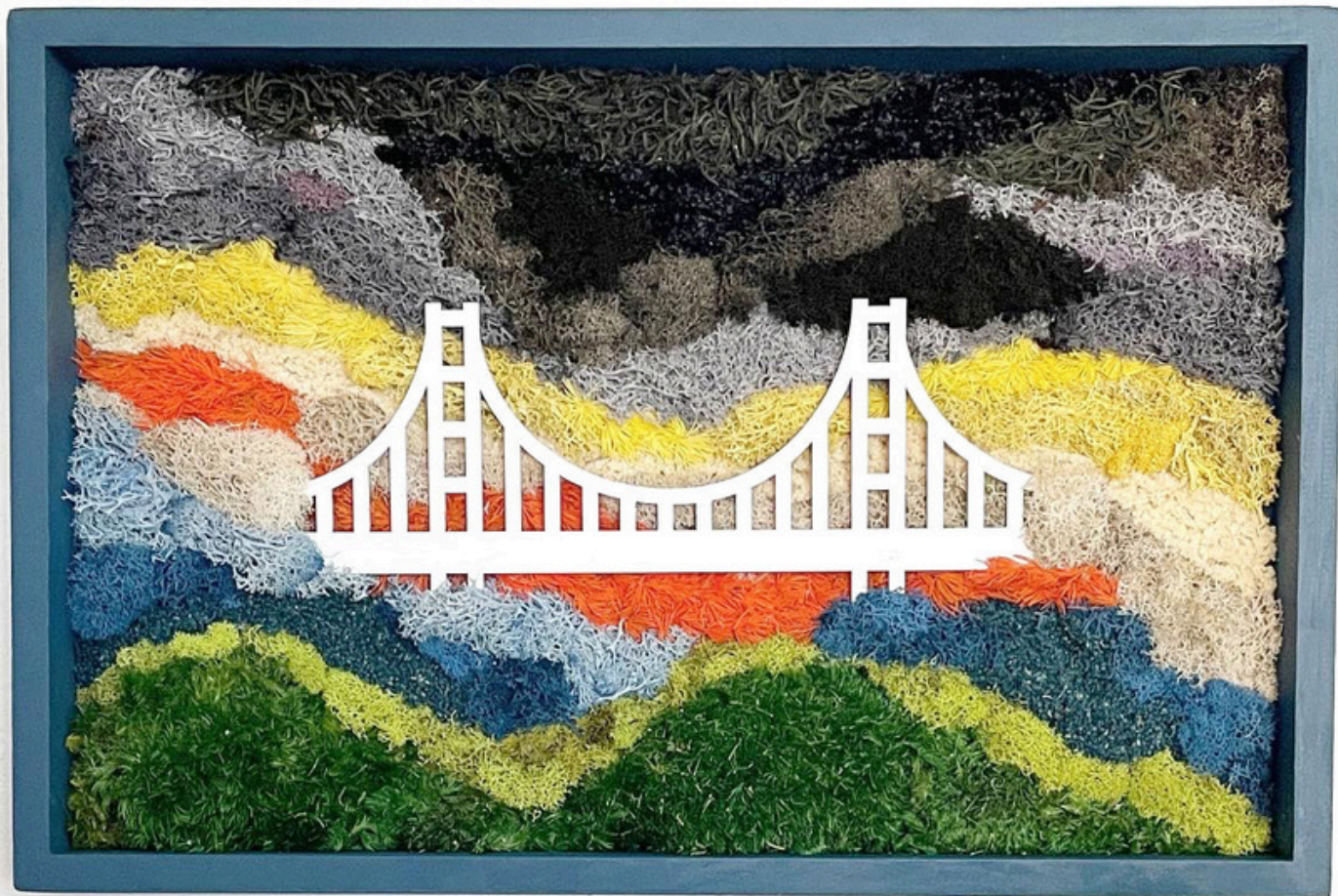


# About Gap Inc. x Nest
